

To connect to the MedtrioEMR web service you will first need to contact MedTrio to receive a username, password, and client name. After obtaining this information you will go to <https://app.medtrio.com/ccdaService/Service.asmx> to see the options that are available on our API. The WSDL will be located at <https://app.medtrio.com/ccdaService/Service.asmx?WSDL>.

## OPTIONS:

**username:** Provided by MedTrio. This is case sensitive.

**password:** Provided by MedTrio. This is case sensitive.

**client:** Provided by MedTrio. This is not case sensitive.

**social:** Enter the SSN of the desired patient without dashes.

**dob:** Enter the date of birth of the desired patient.

**first:** Enter the first name of the desired patient. This is not case sensitive.

**last:** Enter the surname of the desired patient. This is not case sensitive.

**Modules:** Enter the desired modules, separated by commas (,), or "all." This is not case sensitive. A complete list is shown below.

**display:** Enter "true" to create a rendered CCDA. Enter "false" to create a payload of the XML file. This is not case sensitive.
